What's New

- NRV hospitals remain at normal operations, capacity & capabilities, with no interruptions to patient care. There are 7 COVID-19 positive patients hospitalized & 8 persons under investigation.
- RU is busy preparing for a scheduled "Bigger Picture" rally & march, set for Saturday.
- The Business Continuity Team works to provide COVID-19-related services & support. Call 540-427-7341 or 540-505-5173.
- Admissions remain on hold at the Commonwealth Center for Children & Adolescents (CCCA). Northern Virginia Mental Health Institute continues very limited admissions. State hospitals (excluding CCCA) are at 96.5% of capacity. Emergency contracts & mitigation strategies to increase admissions continue.
